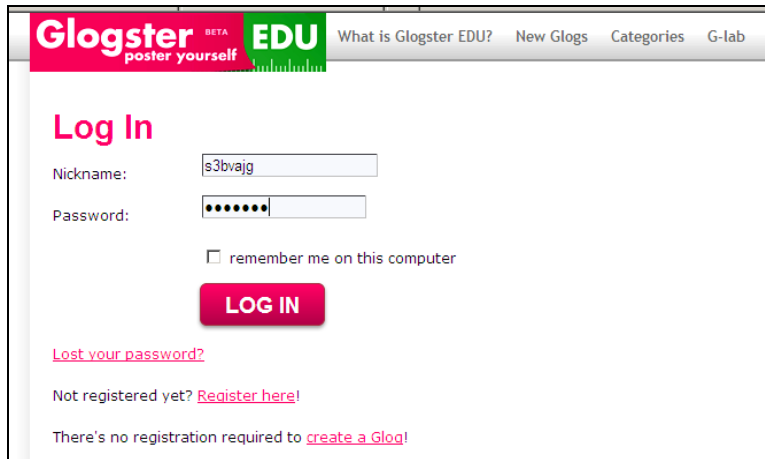


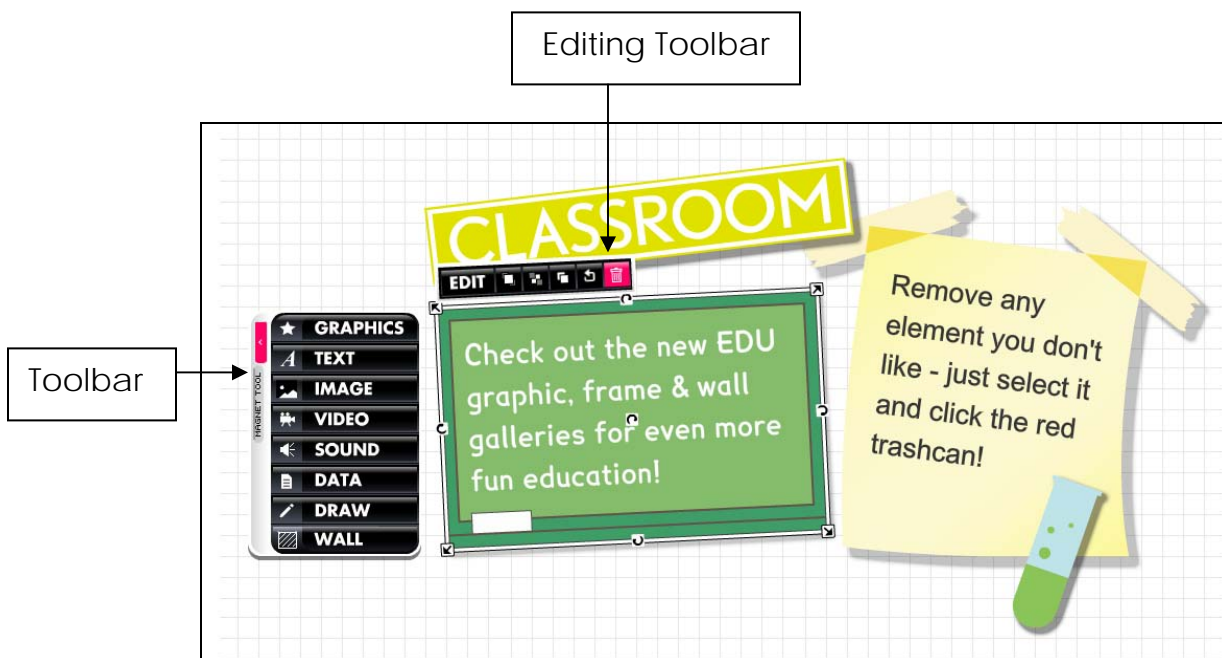
## Glogster

1. Go to <http://edu.glogster.com>
2. Enter the Nickname and Password your teacher created.



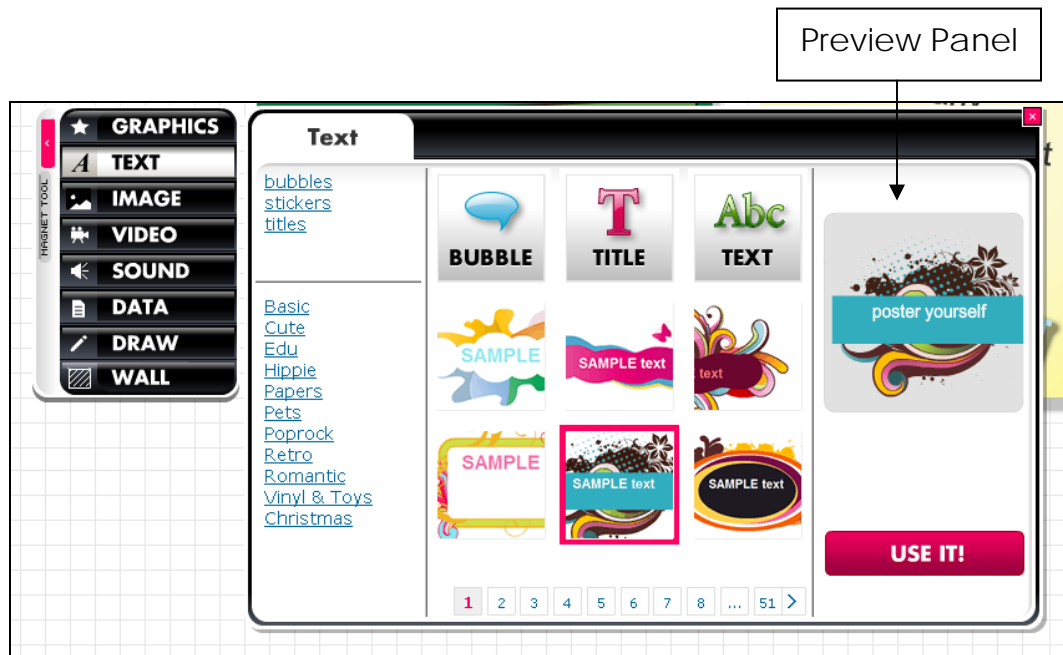

3. Click the **Create New Glog** button.
4. All glogs will begin with the same elements on the work screen. **Click on an element** to select it. Then use the **editing toolbar** to make changes to that element.



NOTE: Use the editing toolbar to edit the text or to resize the element.

5. To add new elements to your glog, use the **toolbar** on the left side of the page.
6. Select the **kind of element** you want to add such as graphics, text or images.
7. Select the specific element you want to add to your page. The **selected element** will have a highlighted box around it.
8. The selected element will appear on the preview panel. Click **Use It** to add that element to your glog.



9. Continue to add elements that will enhance your glog.
10. To close the toolbar, click the small pink **X** in the upper right corner. (It's by the Preview Panel.)

Note: Don't put too many elements on your glog. Add only what will enhance the content of your glog.

11. To see a full preview of your glog, click **Preview**.



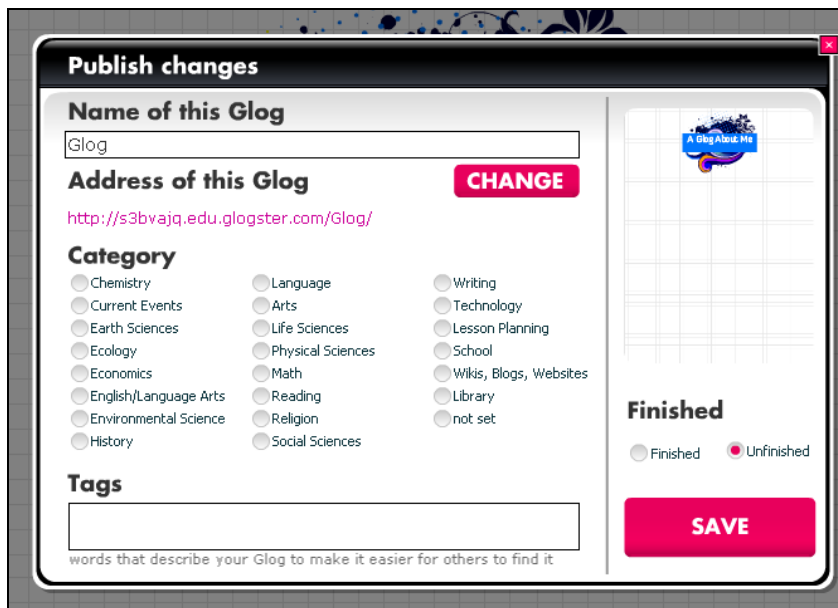
12. Click **Back to Edit** to return to your glog work screen.



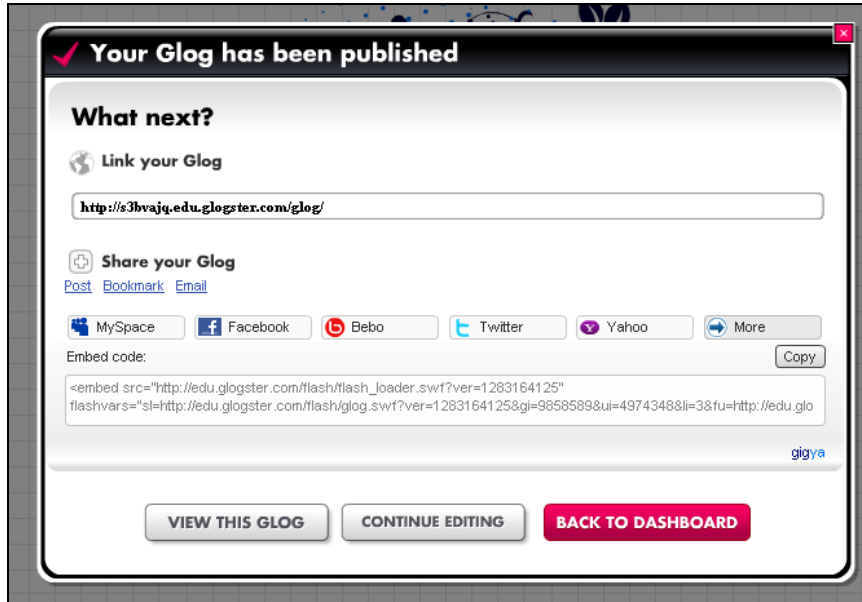
13. To save your glog, click **Save or Publish**.



14. Assign a **name** and **category** to your glog. Tags are optional. Select **Finished** if your glog is complete. Select **Unfinished** if you still need to work on your glog.



15. Click **Save**.
16. A window will appear with a link to your glog. You do not have to write this down now, you can always access it later.



17. Click **Back to Dashboard**.
18. On the Dashboard, you can view the glogs of other classmates or log off.
